



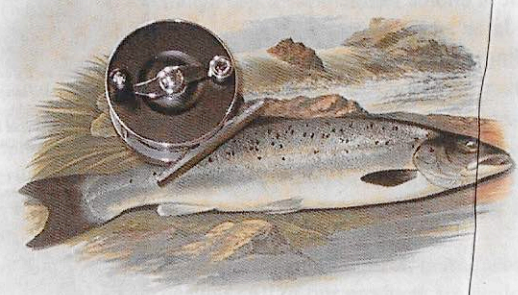

FLY FISHING in JAPAN

The concept of Fly Fishing as a sport was began in Japan over 100 years ago. Especially over the last 30 years, it has become an increasingly popular fishing method among Japanese trout anglers. In Japan there are several species of Trout and Char; Iwana (*Salvelinus leucomaenis*), the anadromous Yamame (*Oncorhynchus masou*), Amago (*Oncorhynchus rhodurus*) as well as the many Salmons (Pacific Salmon) that run the rivers in autumn in Northern Japan. Fly Fishing has become the tactic of choice for the Trout and Salmon angler in Japan and is a permanent part of their angling culture.

We at KINEYA had been a famous camera shop dealing vintage classic cameras such as Leica, Zeiss, Nikon etc. over 60 years in the middle of Kyoto, the old capital city of Japan.

In 1985 the owner, Masatoshi Okui, had started becoming deeply interested in the beauty and elegance of many famous American classic fly fishing tackle, of particular note was his near obsession with vintage bamboo rods and antique reels. He often went to America in his search in obtaining fine tackle and was an active buyer at several famous auctions. In addition, whenever the occasion presented itself, he was excited to introduce the Japanese culture of traditional fishing and fly fishing to American fishermen at some "table shows" and vintage tackle swap meets.

In the early years we gained much experience in our business of importing and distribution in Japan several American tackle makers and in 1990, we started producing fly reels of our own design. To help augment our business we also had arranged to do manufacturing for a few select tackle makers and wholesalers. In 1990, due to the overwhelming demand and short supply of high quality fly reels in the traditional style, we set out to create our own line of premium quality fly reels.

In April of 2000, Kineya discontinued O.E.M. manufacturing and decided to concentrate solely on their own designs. All of our products are made in house and are overseen by Masatoshi Okui who is also an avid fly fisher. He personally directs the operation of Kineya's state of the art CNC lathes. That is why you will see exclusive features and designs not found anywhere else and at a price that is very reasonable considering the superior quality and impeccable craftsmanship that goes into every Kineya design.

At present we are dealing with only 30 retailers in the entire country of Japan. Kineya has gained the respect and praise of fly fishers around the globe by manufacturing high quality products of original design and offering hand made craftsmanship and features and specifications not found on ordinary reels.

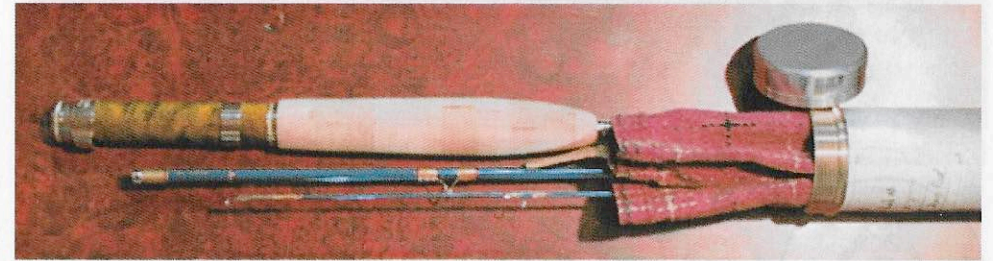

We have two series six models, the MfP series of three piece which thought the soft touch in all distance and the soft presentation as important, and CA series of two piece comfortable to upstream fishing.



MfP (Mid-flex Progressive) Series

Progressive action is adopted in order to realize the same soft touch and the same soft presentation in all distance. Moreover, we design by mid-flex action so that lifting power can be demonstrated, and the margin is given to the bat. Please enjoy the feeling of coexistence of this concept of two points.

CA (Classic American) Series

There were many masterpiece graphite rods of medium-fast action around the 1970s which carried out the best match in the mountain stream of the free stone of the eastern United States, the exquisite feeling reappears, casting, fishing, it both tastes and the rod of classic medium-fast action is made.

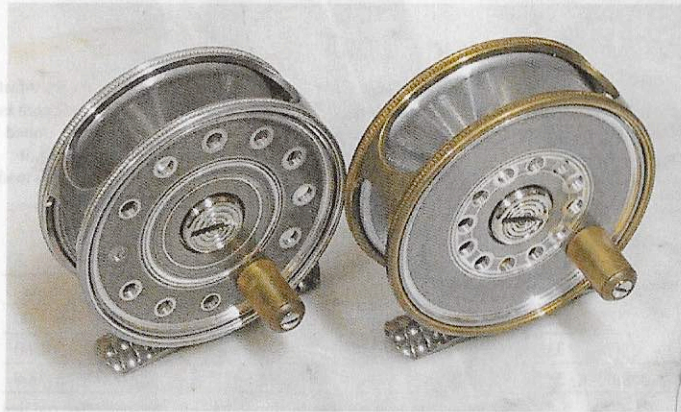

Type A has A6061T6 aluminum frame, Type B has brass frame, Each type has A6061T6 aluminum spool, SUS foot and fittings.

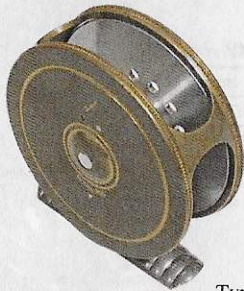


Model 300 for #3 to #4 line.

Model 301 for #4 to #5 line.

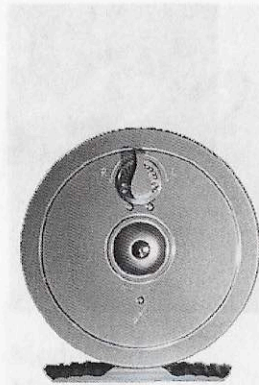

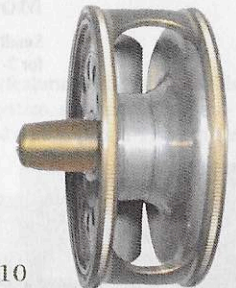
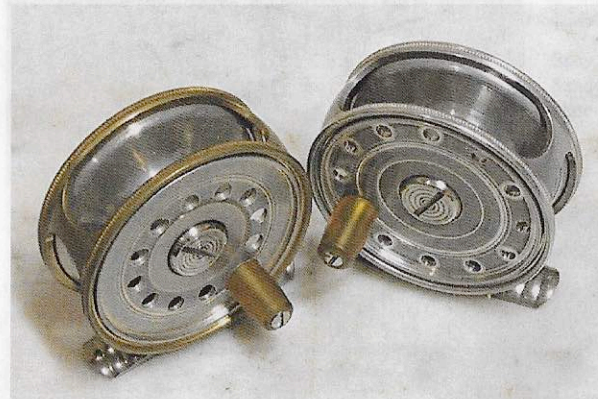
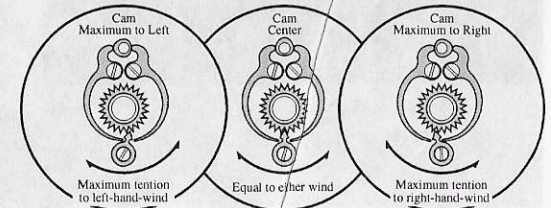


Model 302

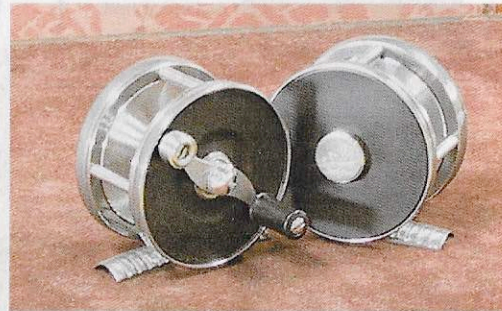

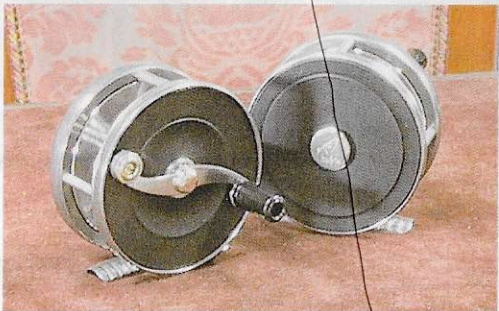

Center shaft and rear cap are made of stainless steel, other parts are made of brass which are polished or plated.

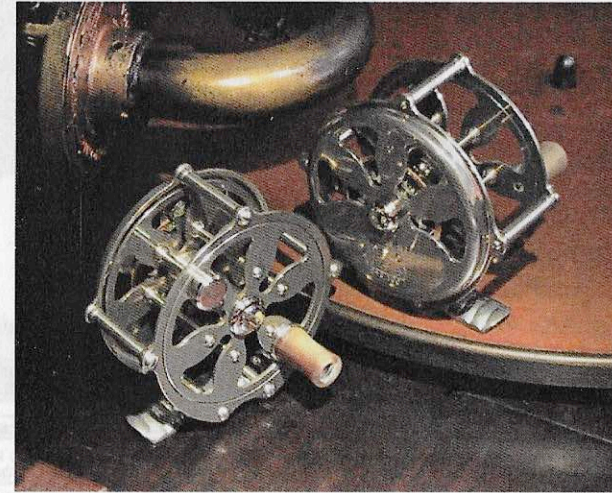
